GIFT AID DECLARATION

This local branch of The RSPCA is a separately registered charity (No: 225689) and as such can claim the tax paid by you on money you donate to the branch without it costing you another penny! Simply put, the Government refunds tax paid by you, this means that if you give £10 to charity using Gift Aid, that gift is worth £12.82 to the charity. This is because 22 per cent of £12.82 is £2.82 – your £10 being the difference.

The Gift Aid scheme is only for monetary gifts and there are rules limiting the value of benefits you can receive in return. Higher Rate tax payers generate more than 22 percent for us.

To get that extra money to us, simply complete and sign this declaration returning it to our Treasurer at the address shown on our web site. Thank you.
